AGREEMENT

All Coaching Staff and Members of the Club are responsible for the development of player skills and enjoyment of Rugby League, as well as promoting positive attitudes towards The Oaks Junior Rugby League Football Club and sport in general.

On acceptance of the role you have been nominated/approved for (refer page 1), you agree to:

- Hold appropriate qualifications as stipulated by Group 6 and the NSWRL. If you do not currently have the appropriate accreditations, you agree to obtain them at your earliest opportunity. You will not be able to carry out your role until appropriate qualifications have been obtained.
- Abide by the rules of the club, group and governing bodies at all times and encourage players and other officials to also abide by these rules.
- Encourage players and officials to support and respect the NRL National Code of Conduct.
- Encourage Players to become involved in Rugby League as a safe, healthy and enjoyable activity.
- To take full responsibility for all property belonging to the club that is allocated to you during the season, including that which is made available to you during the season. Ensure all club property is returned upon the completion of the season.
- Encourage Players to develop a proper attitude to competitiveness.
- Foster club spirit amongst all players and parents and encourage them to participate in club operations and functions.
- Liaise with the club's coaching co-ordinator and other officials when required. Ask for assistance when needed. Remember, club members and officials are here to help.
- Attend training and development clinics as organised by the Club or Group 6.
- Be/Become a financial member of The Oaks Junior Rugby League Football Club for the current season (\$10 membership applies, payable to the Treasurer).
- Attend majority of the club's General or Committee meetings.
- Attend Coaches and Managers meetings where applicable and required.
- Understand that you are responsible to pay any fines or penalties imposed by Group 6 that you may incur.
- Understand that failure to comply with this agreement will affect future applications you may have or submit.

This agreement is to ensure consistency with the player's development and to allow the opportunity for involvement and feedback to enhance our club going forward.
